WOLVERHAMPTON RAILWAY STATION

Fast, frequent trains are available from Wolverhampton Railway Station to Birmingham (New Street), as well as to Stafford, Telford and Shrewsbury. Trains also continue beyond Birmingham to Birmingham International (for Airport & NEC) and Coventry.

Trains are also available to destinations further afield, including London Euston, the south coast, Stoke-on-Trent, Manchester, Liverpool, north-west of England, Wales and Scotland.



CITY CENTRE TRAM STOPS

Fast and frequent trams to Birmingham (Edgbaston Village), West Bromwich, Wednesbury and Bilston are also available from the Piper's Row tram stop.
