


Certain Sunday Service X21 journeys continue to Halesowen, Colley Gate,
 Quarry Bank and Merry Hill Centre.

Fast, frequent trains are available from University railway station to Birmingham (New Street).



In addition, most trains to Birmingham also continue to Duddeston, Aston, Gravelly Hill, Erdington, Chester Road, Wylde Green, Sutton Coldfield, Four Oaks, Butlers Lane, Blake Street, Shenstone and Lichfield.
